Duly called into Session on June 21, 2021, now hereby issues the following in accordance with Louisiana Revised Statute 15:121 and pursuant to the order of the 1st Judicial District Court dated 6/30/2021 as deemed applicable:

On June 24, 2021, the Grand Jury of the First Judicial District Court inspected Caddo Correctional Center located at 1101 Forum Drive, Shreveport, Louisiana 71107. There are one thousand two hundred seventy eight (1278) prisoners and inmates. The cost of maintenance per prisoner/inmate is approximately seventy-eight dollars (\$78.00) US Currency per day. The length of time that each prisoner awaiting trial varies widely as per attached exhibit #1. The inspection revealed that there are no standard medical protocols in place for treatment of the inmates. There is no triage distinction between an inmate being seen on a first visit as compared to an inmate who has a continual medical complaint lasting multiple days. Moreover, the two binders containing some previous protocols are not used and are outdated.

Based on their inspection of Caddo Correctional Center, the Grand Jury found there were areas in the medical unit that could be improved upon by instituting the following:

1. Develop updated standing protocols for all indications for seeking further medical consultation for use for all current and future personnel in accordance and consistent with any and all up to date state and national standards and protocol for emergency medical services, clinical standards and treatment protocols (for example: call medical doctor or Director if patient has a second visit for same complaint, chest pain, fever, not eating or drinking, etc.).
2. Bi-annual refresher training of medical personnel to discuss protocol, best practices, when to call for assistance, CPR updates, role play and when to call for assistance in accordance and consistent with state and national standards and protocol for emergency medical services, clinical standards and treatment protocols.
3. Review staffing levels for all shifts
 - a. Incorporate experienced staff with less experienced staff (nights and weekends)
4. Develop standard medical exam routines in accordance and consistent with state and national standards and protocol for medical exam/services, clinical standards and treatment protocols.
 - a. Red flag complaints get a full medical exam with any and all update to date state and national standards and protocol for emergency medical services, clinical standards and treatment protocols.

The Grand Jury also makes the following recommendations:

1. Acquire an EMR – Electronic Medical Record system;

2. Hire a midlevel medical provider;
3. Purchase new medical equipment to meet the needs of any and all update to standards and protocol for emergency medical services, clinical standards and treatment protocols.;
4. Institute competitive pay for medical staff;

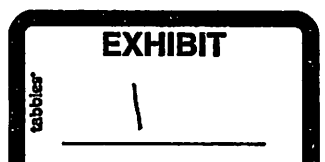
